IT'S THE LAW!

- 1) This document must be completed and signed by a licensed health care provider.
- 2) Virginia State Law 22.1-271.2 requires that a child must present documentary proof of immunization before he/she can attend any public, private or parochial school. Dates (month, day, and year) of administration of all vaccines are required.
- 3) Only vaccines marked with an asterisk are currently required for school entry.

***Minimum Immunization Requirements for Entry into Virginia Schools (requirements are subject to change)**

- Four (4) doses of DTaP vaccine are required, with one (1) dose being administered on or after the fourth birthday.
- Four (4) doses of polio vaccine are required, with one (1) dose being administered on or after the fourth birthday.
- Hib - 2/3 doses in infancy; 1 booster between 12-15 months; 1 dose between 15-60 months if unvaccinated, for children up to 60 months of age only
- Pneumococcal - 2-4 doses, depending on age at 1st dose for children up to 2 years of age only
- 2 Measles - one dose on/after 12 months of age; 2nd dose prior to entering kindergarten
- 2 Mumps - on/after 12 months of age, and before entering kindergarten
- 1 Rubella - on/after 12 months of age
- Note: Measles, Mumps, Rubella requirements also met with 2 MMR -1st dose on/after 12 months of age; 2nd dose prior to entering kindergarten
- Hepatitis B - 3 doses required (2 doses if Merck adult formulation given between 11-15 years of age; check the indicated box in on front if this formulation was used)
- 2 Varicella - on/after 12 months of age, and before entering kindergarten

***Additional Immunizations Required at Entry into 7th Grade – July 2021**

- Tdap - booster required for entry into 7th grade if at least 5 years since last tetanus-containing vaccine (effective 7/2019)
- Hepatitis A series will be required for school entry. This two dose series includes a 1st dose on/after 12 months of age; 2nd dose six months after 1st dose. Series can be given any time after 12 months of age (**effective 7/2021**)
- Meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY) will be required for 7th grade school entry. This two dose series includes a 1st dose prior to 7th grade; 2nd dose prior to 12th grade entry (**effective 7/2021**)
- HPV is required but parents may opt out.
